- Campers will enjoy the program cost-free; all expenses will be covered by Saint Sophia.
- The program take place on July 12-14, 2019 at Saint Sophia Camp.
- Applications for the program will be posted on Saint Sophia's website on May 29.

- Daily activities will include arts and crafts, pool and field games while other typical activities will include summer Olympics, campfires, a basketball tournament, themed dances and free time.
